protection control and accounting systems mpc a adequate resources must be provided to facilities where weapon usable material is located for upgrading and maintaining mpc a systems additionally the technical security systems that are being installed through the cooperative program need to be fully embraced by russian managers and specialists the report recommends the establishment of a ten year indigenization fund of about 500 million provided by russia and its g 8 partners as a new mechanism for gradually shifting the financial burden of mpc a to the russian government
