the state of global air soga report published in partnership with the un children s fund unicef warns on wednesday that air pollution is increasingly impacting human health and is now the second leading global risk factor for premature death the fifth edition of the report released by the health effects institute hei revealed that

more than 90 per cent of these global air pollution deaths 7 8 million people are attributed to pm 2 5 air pollution including from ambient pm 2 5 and household air pollution these tiny particles measuring less than 2 5 micrometers in diameter are so small they remain in the lungs and can enter the bloodstream affecting many organ
