John Milton was not only the greatest English Renaissance poet but also devoted twenty years to prose writing in the advancement of religious, civil, and political liberties. The height of his public career was as chief propagandist to the Commonwealth regime which came into being following the execution of King Charles I in 1649. The first of the two complete texts in this volume, *The Tenure of Kings and Magistrates*, was easily the most radical justification of the regicide at the time. In the second, *A Defence of the People of England*, Milton undertook to vindicate the Commonwealth's cause to Europe as a whole.
