biofilm pathogenicity in the oral cavity is magnified by two biofilm characteristics increased antibiotic resistance and the inability of the community to be phagocytized by host inflammatory cells the key characteristics of biofilm that could be targets for pathogen management include its behavior as an adhesive mass with viscoelastic properties its activity as a coordinated multi species community in which cells communicate via small molecules and its inflammatory disease potential to understand the mechanism of change from health to disease and their interaction with the host s reactions more in depth information of the metabolic activities controlling and governing biological processes at the species species level is now required an improved understanding of biofilm will lead to new strategies for management of oral diseases in the near future it is expected that the correlation between biofilm maturation and activation of specific genes of the inner microorganisms will be clarified at the molecular level
