**African Short Stories in English** 1985 long story short is a collection of 20 diverse indie short stories from over a thousand submissions these 20 short stories were handpicked to create this anthology aptly put this book holds inside it not just a diverse collection of stories but also a wide range of emotions including love loss and nostalgia that these authors want you to experience 20 offbeat stories from 20 promising writers this anthology is a must have if you are looking for a quick getaway from your everyday hassles

The Modern Tradition 1979 the irish have always had a way with words long ago they took on a language not their own and learned to re word it into pure magic nowhere is this magic more in evidence than in their short stories stories that combine lyricism humor and tragedy with rare imagination set in simple backgrounds largely without props the seemingly effortless art of the best irish writers has an appeal that is naive and highly sophisticated at the same time the disarming simplicity with which the tales are spun being somewhat misleading at first reading in this anthology there are gathered for the first time in america some of the more representative examples of irish short fiction the emphasis is on variety all are a delight to read all have universal appeal only 21 of the 44 have previously been published in this country

*Micro Fiction* 1996 presents a collection of eight short stories of victories and defeats in various sports including karate track wrestling baseball basketball and football

**Long Story Short** 2020-11-05 short fiction an anthology is a collection of 80 short stories and 2 novellas it offers a wide variety of selections from the mid 19th century to the present and includes a number of works by young and rarely anthologised authors the stories are arranged chronologically according to the date of birth of the author the introductory essay closely critiques two short stories chekhov s the lady with the pet dog from the 19th century and carver s post world war two story about chekhov errand the introduction enables the editors to demonstrate methods of critical approaches to short fiction and literature in general thereby helping students to develop their own critical abilities

44 Irish Short Stories 1955 this anthology of faithful translations of the classics is by far the best of its kind to come out for a long time canadian slavic review
