the structure of the medicare part d prescription drug program generally encourages plan sponsors to submit low bids however rules in the program relating to low income beneficiaries generate a different set of incentives for plans seeking to serve those beneficiaries this report finds that over the first five years of the part d program two types of plans emerged those that catered primarily to beneficiaries receiving low income subsidies lis plans and those that catered primarily to standard beneficiaries non lis plans for each additional plan sponsor that entered the market non lis basic plans reduced their bids by a statistically significant 0.40 to 0.70 or 5.8 per month of coverage on average while the bids of lis plans did not respond in a statistically significant way lis plans were also more likely to increase their bids so that their premiums approached the maximum premium subsidy called the low income benchmark figures and tables this is a print on demand report
