# updated cervical cancer screening guidelines acog

primary human papillomavirus testing in 2020 the american cancer society acs updated its cervical cancer screening guidelines to recommend primary hrhpv testing as the preferred screening option for average risk individuals aged 25 65 years 5

the hpv test and the pap test can help prevent cervical cancer or find it early you should start getting pap tests at age 21 if you are 30 years old or older talk to your doctor about testing options

screening initiation screening should begin at 21 years of age regardless of age at sexual initiation or other behavior related risk factors table 1 summarizes screening methods and frequency

# cervical cancer screening united states preventive
