that he has no hope of achieving writing 100 000 words in one day at first he takes baby steps averaging 25 000 words per day before encountering his first obstacle with a little ingenuity can the eccentric author conquer his dream or is he totally out of his league approximately 5 400 words in all excerpt from the crappiest author borges svelt wasn t about to hit the new york times bestseller list anytime soon heavens no he was one of those dreadful self published authors eek shunned by the industry and despised by his traditionally published peers like them he was eccentric in many ways from his tacky plaid socks that doubled as hand warmers to naming every member of the brady bunch whenever he reached a mental roadblock while some writers prefer to stand while they write or sail the seven seas while banging away on their trusty typewriter borges felt right at home on his shiny porcelain throne of course he didn t mount the toilet with all of his clothes on that would suggest that he was the least bit sane on the contrary he did not wear a shred of clothing he was the pantless author ready for anything that came rumbling through his feeble brain or lower intestine critically examines influential novels in english by eminent black female writers studying these writers key engagements with nationalism race and gender during apartheid and the transition to democracy barbara boswell traces the ways in which black women s fiction criticality interrogates narrow ideas of nationalism she examines who is included and excluded while producing alternative visions for a more just south african society this is an erudite analysis of ten well known south african writers spanning the apartheid and post apartheid era miriam tlali lauretta ngcobo farida karodia agnes sam success came at a price however womack lost his friend and mentor sam cooke when the soul star was gunned down in a motel a doomed marriage to cooke s widow followed which severely damaged his reputation in the music business tragically he lost two sons one to suicide as well as his brother harry to a brutal murder his escape was to turn to drugs years of riotous abuse took their toll on womack and those closest to him including janis joplin who spent her last night drinking with the singer but womack s talent searing guitar and soulful voice always survived cited as an influence by myriad musicians even in death he remains the epitome of cool honest insightful and unflinching this is the authentic voice of the midnight mover a supremely talented legend of music whose every day was lived to the full essential reading for any music lover the independent her face is simply unmistakable as the council house based brothel madam lillian in channel 4 s long running brilliant cult drama shameless based on a manchester sink estate by her own admission not exactly the bridget bardot of the north west she is fiercely and unapologetically proud of her working class roots and the many obstacles she has overcome in forging an acting career in her long awaited autobiography she details her almost barbaric treatment as a youngster during her formative school years at the hands of bigoted bullies both pupils and teachers alike she describes how one day after being beaten for being a catholic in the morning and beaten for being a protestant in the afternoon she eventually fought back it was a turning point in alice s life she became a rebel and beat one of the bullies so badly she ended up in hospital not surprisingly they never bothered her again who the hell is alice is deep and personal warts and all the humour of alice barry shines like a beacon on every page but she also shares with the reader her real life tragedies such as the tragic circumstances surrounding the death of her brother tommy and her husband terry her current relationship with her partner jeff is also well documented too they love and respect each other of that there is no doubt the only slight twist in their magical bond is that jeff is gay and their relationship is purely a plutonic one alice also takes the reader onto the set of shameless the long running channel 4 show is quite simply a phenomenon and has been an on going part of her life for over nine years alice talks at length about the entire team and her special relationship with sally carmen kelly maguire david threlfall frank gallagher jack deam marty and elliot tittensor carl gallagher once as the winter ended a little bird emerged to find the world had gone quiet the streets were empty and the playgrounds
