for the new testament writers the old testament scriptures and the teachings of jesus were key sources of authority and influence when these influences are considered alongside each other each can illuminate the other deepening the new testament writers presentation of jesus and our understanding of their interpretations in jesus and scripture tom parker examines the way in which hebrews james and 1 and 2 peter deal with these two different sources of authority how they relate to each other and what shifts have occurred historically and theologically within the writing of these texts treating the four epistles methodologically parker examines the particular ways in which each writer draws on the hebrew scriptures ultimately he argues convincingly that the nascent jesus tradition particularly via oral routes influenced the way the old testament was processed by these various new testament writers in jesus and women niamh middleton combines insights from evolutionary biology feminism and the metoo movement to highlight the revolutionary attitude of jesus towards women her careful exegesis comparing the treatment and depiction of women in the old and new testaments illuminates the way forward for the treatment of women by church and society more importantly however it holds the potential to greatly enrich our understanding of jesus divinity middleton s bold approach encourages christian women to reclaim their religion as a tool for empowerment correcting the regressive course that christianity has taken in this regard since roman times she also cites the remarkable life and untimely death of western heroine diana princess of wales as an archetypal example of why christianity must be reclaimed by its female members above all she powerfully argues that while political feminism can tackle the symptoms of the perennial battle of the sexes only a revolution of grace can bring about a full restoration of the harmony between the sexes described in genesis first published in 1941 the historic mission of jesus is one of the landmark texts on the life of jesus his relation to the father and his earthly task counter to the prevailing scepticism of the reliability of the synoptic sources chronicling jesus life cadoux presents a sweeping yet detailed illustration of the evidence while advancing theories for its interpretation that would go on to be significant facets of new testament study while not going to the same lengths as albert schweitzer cadoux nevertheless advances a thoroughly eschatological interpretation of jesus self perception he thus emphasises the nation wide character of his appeal his concern for the redemption of the gentiles through israel s fulfilment of the universalistic aspirations of the old testament his eager endeavour to avert a military clash between the jews and the roman empire and his early expectation of being accepted and loyally followed by his fellow countrymen as a whole the result is a prime early example of the revival of interest in the historical jesus on theological grounds the titles of jesus in christology was recognised as a major contribution to christological study when it was first published in german in 1963 its translation into english a few years later cemented this status hahn undertakes a massive and detailed examination of the various traditions that led to the use of names for jesus that we now recognise as characteristic of the very early church moreover he carefully distinguishes between the different christological conceptions present in these differing branches of primitive christianity and embodied in the terms they produced his analysis and categories have been followed by many later scholars who built on his detailed study of the peculiarities of the different titles given to jesus by the different communities that followed him unraveled is a 30 day devotional that focuses on developing spiritual emotional and mental growth from a biblical perspective the devotions sole purpose is leading individuals into a deeper intimate relationship with christ every devotion is geared to inspire encourage and motivate the reader to take a deeper cristianismo gira alrededor de Jesús de Nazaret en cuanto realidad histórica es camino al Cristo y salvaguarda de su realidad esta realidad es en definitiva buena noticia eu aggelion el recto pensar de la ortodoxia debe ir acompañado por el recto actuar en el seguimiento de Jesús la ortopraxis y por el recto dejarse afectar por Jesús de Nazaret así lo han dicho en la línea de este artículo Leonardo Boff e Ignacio Ellacuría y así lo dijo desde su propia teología Karl Rahner em modernidade e discurso econômico Leda Paulani professora de economia da USP dedica-se a um ofício cada dia mais raro na sua área de estudo analisar as raízes filosóficas e ideológicas das ideias e dos discursos na economia em um mundo onde a política econômica é tratada como engrenagem mecânica sem opção poemas fortemente inspirado pelo filósofo húngaro György Lukács Konder busca uma definição do que é realismo e sua relação com a força das grandes obras de arte quase cem anos depois da primeira revolta proletária bem sucedida no mundo a revolução russa quando a palavra revolução de certo modo se banaliza e alguns chegam a proclamar o fim da história a boitempo editorial publica uma antologia que reúne alguns dos principais textos clássicos do pensamento marxista as armas da crítica organizado por Ivana Jinkings e Emir Sader traz textos de Karl Marx Friedrich Engels Vladimir Lenin Leon Trotsky Rosa Luxemburgo e Antonio Gramsci a escolha pelos marxistas para esta coleção se deve ao fato de o marxismo constituir a espinha dorsal das teorias e práticas da esquerda desde que esta se firmou como força política e ideológica ao longo do século XX este livro inaugura um projeto planejado para três volumes divididos entre os autores clássicos os do chamado marxismo ocidental e os contemporâneos abrindo o primeiro volume dos clássicos estão escritos dos fundadores do marxismo Marx e Engels seguem-se a eles textos redigidos pelos mais destacados teóricos e dirigentes políticos do ciclo revolucionário do fim dos anos 1910 e do momento imediatamente posterior à primeira guerra mundial Lenin Trotsky Rosa Luxemburgo e Gramsci todos são exemplos consagrados da capacidade de articulação entre teoria e prática reflexão e ação nos momentos de ascensão e de refluxo do movimento comunista very few if any have devoted more years to practicing and teaching others to practice the precepts of Jesus's sermon on the mount than Leo Tolstoy he stands apart in the history of interpretation and has had enormous influence on others and other countries yet Gandhi or others often get the glory Tolstoy is remembered as a great writer but his religious and philosophical works are by and large unknown or disparaged even in scholarly Tolstoyan circles his contribution is substantially under appreciated and misunderstood in second Tolstoy the sermon on the mount as Theo Tactis Steve Hickey captures the particulars and dynamics of Tolstoy's interpretation of the sermon on the mount from a deliberately sympathetic vantage point underlying this project is shared belief with Tolstoy that the sermon on the mount is liveable and to be lived while from the vantage point of traditional orthodoxy Tolstoy got much wrong there remains a lack of appreciation for what he got right radical obedience to the teachings of Jesus a new vocabulary is proposed to more precisely capture Tolstoyan lived theology namely the political and social expressions of Tolstoyan Christianity with the hope that these theories and practices will gain a wider consideration understanding and following o capitalismo como religião apresenta um recorrido por ensaios do filósofo Walter Benjamin organizado e introduzido pelo sociólogo Michael Löwy o livro traz textos surpreendentes em particular os ditos de juventude que vêm à tona com a liberação da obra Benjaminiana para o domínio público

löwy reuniu escritos de benjamin inéditos em português ou difíceis de consultar que contêm em graus variados uma crítica radical da civilização capitalista industrial moderna segundo o organizador benjamin ocupa uma posição singular na história do pensamento crítico moderno É o primeiro seguidor do materialismo histórico a romper radicalmente com a ideologia do progresso linear por sua crítica radical da civilização burguesa moderna por sua desconstrução da ideologia do progresso a grande narrativa dos tempos modernos comum tanto aos liberais quanto aos socialistas os escritos de benjamin parecem um bloco errático à margem das principais correntes da cultura moderna em o emprego na globalização a nova divisão internacional do trabalho e os caminhos que o brasil escolheu marcio pochmann faz rigorosa genealogia do desemprego e da precarização do trabalho na atualidade em linguagem acessível o autor aborda temas que auxiliam o leitor a entender o mercado de trabalho brasileiro estruturado em cinco partes o livro contempla uma discussão inicial sobre a nova repartição do trabalho no mundo em seguida aborda sua evolução a partir do declínio do número de ocupações na terceira e quarta partes são analisadas as situações de desemprego no mundo e no brasil a última trata das potencialidades que podem ser mobilizadas no enfrentamento do excedente de mão de obra em nosso país apoiando se em vasto e consistente volume de dados o autor revela a verdadeira tragédia social embutida nas políticas econômicas ditas modernizantes além disso mostra que no brasil poucas empresas estão preparadas para incorporar novas técnicas que aumentam a produtividade e podem causar desemprego pochmann levanta ainda um conjunto de políticas que podem ajudar a reverter as tendências desfavoráveis mostradas ao longo de o emprego na globalização oferecendo ao leitor uma visão original sobre assuntos de crucial importância para o desenvolvimento do país presidente do instituto de pesquisa econômica aplicada ipea marcio pochmann lança pela boitempo um estudo sobre a mobilidade na base da pirâmide social brasileira durante o início do século xxi nova classe média analisa as recentes transformações na sociedade e refuta a idéia de surgimento de uma nova classe no país muito menos a de uma nova classe média o resgate da condição de pobreza e o aumento do padrão de consumo afirma pochmann não tiram a maioria da população emergente da classe trabalhadora para ele é preciso a politização classista do fenômeno para aprofundar a transformação da estrutura social sem a qual a massa popular em emergência ganha um caráter predominantemente mercadológico individualista e conformista sobre a natureza e a dinâmica das mudanças socioeconômicas no brasil pochmann faz nesse livro uma reflexão sobre transformações recentes ocorridas no país com a volta do crescimento econômico e as características das ocupações e das relações de trabalho na base da pirâmide social e em cada um dos capítulos defende pontos de vistas que não são consensuais entre os especialistas o que torna ainda mais importante a sua leitura afirma josé dari krein professor do instituto de economia da unicamp e autor do texto de orelha em contraposição à visão predominante que busca explicar o atual processo pela emergência de uma nova classe média o livro mostra que apesar dos avanços recentes a dinâmica das ocupações e do rendimento requer algo mais do que a inserção das pessoas no mercado de consumo a análise dos dados mais recentes mostra que a melhora dos indicadores na distribuição da renda do trabalho e de seu aumento na participação da riqueza gerada concentra se fundamentalmente na base da pirâmide social o que revela também os seus limites inspirada no diário de viagens de mario de andrade pelo norte e nordeste do brasil maíra soares ferreira apresenta em seu novo livro a rima na escola o verso na história a luta pela preservação da cultura popular afro indígena e sertaneja e sua transmissão às novas gerações em comunidades como a da favela do real parque na capital paulista formada por migrantes descendentes da aldeia pankararu pe este livro resultou de sua pesquisa intervenção em torno da criação poética desenvolvida em sala de aula com professores e alunos do 8o ano do ensino fundamental a obra ganhadora do prêmio patativa do assaré minc 2010 rastreia o processo de subjetivação de um coletivo de trabalhadores afro indígenas sertanejos que após ter sido trazido para são paulo na década de 1950 como mão de obra da construção do estádio do morumbi ocupou um terreno à beira da marginal pinheiros ali uma comunidade se formou à moda dos aldeamentos forçados observados desde o brasil colônia e a abolição da escravatura nas mais diversas regiões do país que obrigavam negros indígenas e homens brancos livres pobres a viver juntos e aprisionados como parte da política de miscigenação e apagamento de seus traços étnicos e culturais para gerar homens sem vínculos por outro lado como parte da resistência a essas mesmas imposições e modalidades de dominação surgiram as mais diversas formas de hibridismos culturais a partir das dificuldades de inserção dessa comunidade na única escola pública de ensino fundamental da região a jovem pesquisadora foi buscar o verso e a poesia popular remanescentes no nordeste reaquecidos pelas formas híbridas de composição poética e musical contemporâneas no caso entre o tradicional repente e o rap maíra ressalta o potencial crítico e transformador dessa confluência formas que a seu ver expressam uma reinvenção da cultura popular nordestina ao apropriar se do novo combinando o com o velho in this book nigel wright brings together the two concerns that have defined his ministry the formation of healthy congregational life and the considered articulation of christian convictions in the belief that these two concerns are intimately related

he sets out the range of christian convictions in a way intended to be accessible to church members who wish to clarify and deepen their understanding the book is rooted in the belief that the resurrection of christ is the central reality out of which all other christian convictions emerge beginning at this point and in the belief that christ is present in the community of believers the book then explores christian convictions about god christology creation salvation election evil eschatology and witness to the world tommaso santini together with the sanctum consilium solutionum is called again to solve a mysterious case that undermines the roots of the church thirty three years earlier the semen of a boy possessed by the devil was taken to fertilize a young woman nine months later belial bompiani was born a satanic sect made belial the new antichrist thanks to a profane text called the dark bible a nefarious prophecy will make belial at the beginning of his thirty third year of life a destructive instrument that will want to mortally strike the church by making use of that execrable text once again the solver will find himself facing an unspeakable enemy he and his team are given the task of finding who may be the man who embodies the son of satan and to kill him before he can make it to his thirty third year of life

com uma abordagem que transpassa história e teatro o livro organizado por kátia paranhos contribui para a pesquisa na área das ciências humanas tanto com uma discussão sobre teoria e fontes documentais quanto com análises das complexas relações entre leitor e história ficção e vida na apresentação da obra kátia discute como a redefinição do campo de ação do pesquisador contemporâneo leva o texto teatral a ser entendido como mais um elemento constitutivo com o qual se trama o fio da história e não como documento central de suas reflexões o que não significa banir o texto teatral desse espectro de discussão mas compreender o fato teatral como uma rede de relações dinâmicas que transitam entre a semiologia a história a sociologia a antropologia a técnica e a arte a representação e a política a atividade teatral dialoga com outros campos do fazer artístico e assim é lógico que se incentive uma história que dê conta das relações verificadas dentro e fora do fenômeno teatral afirma kátia
