for her thirteenth birthday Anne Frank received a diary as a present from her father. She kept it from 12 June 1942 to 1 August 1944 in this diary which she addressed to an imaginary friend called Kitty. Anne wrote about her life first in Nazi-occupied Amsterdam and then when the Nazi persecution of Jews forced her family into hiding in the sealed-off back rooms of an Amsterdam office building which they referred to as the secret annex. Anne had always dreamed of being a writer and hoped one day to publish her diary.
