house seven prominent historians examine how the leadership of six presidents and an issue that grew into a difficult and often unpopular war shaped each other focusing on the personalities politics priorities and actions of the presidents as they confronted vietnam the authors consider the expansion of presidential power in foreign policy formulation since world war ii in their analyses they
