Social Status and Farm Tenure 1938 forced out a nikkei woman s search for a home in america offers insight into voluntary evacuation a little known japanese american experience during world war ii and the lasting effects of cultural trauma of the roughly 120 000 people forced from their homes by executive order 9066 around 5 000 were able to escape incarceration beforehand by fleeing inland in a series of beautifully written essays judy kawamoto recounts her family s flight from their home in washington to wyoming their later moves to montana and colorado and the influence of those experiences on the rest of her life hers is a story shared by the many families who lost everything and had to start over in often suspicious and hostile environments kawamoto vividly illustrates the details of her family s daily life the discrimination and financial hardship they experienced and the isolation that came from experiencing the horrors of the 1940s very differently than many other japanese americans chapters address her personal and often unconscious reactions to her parents trauma as well as her own subsequent travels around much of the world exploring learning enjoying but also unconsciously acting out a continual search for a home showing how the impacts of traumatic events are collective and generational kawamoto draws interconnections between her family s displacement and later aspects of her life and juxtaposes the impact of her early experiences and questions of identity culture and assimilation forced out will be of great interest to the general reader as well as students and scholars of ethnic studies asian american studies history education and mental health 2022 asian pacific american award for literature honor title adult non fiction literature 2022 evans handcart award winner

Family Farm Program 1958 during his time as a POW Frank Foo Fujita kept a diary of daily happenings embellished with drawings of life in the camp he secreted the diary in the walls of his barracks as the practice was forbidden that diary forms the basis of these memoirs Fujita's memoirs are also unique in that he was one of the fewer than nine hundred Americans taken prisoner on the island of Java the bulk of American POWs in Japanese hands surrendered in the Philippines and most of the published POW memoirs reflect their experience Fujita's account of the defense of Java and of the fate of the lost Battalion of Texas Artillerymen serves to distinguish this memoir from others at one point while a POW in Japan Fujita was forced to be part of the Japanese radio group broadcasting propaganda after the war he testified at some of the war crime trials in San Francisco and the diary on which this book is based was used as evidence in those trials

Farm Friends and Spring Flowers 1913 founded in 1834 by a small group of Quakers protesting human slavery in the South Westfield and Washington Township served as an important home station on the underground railroad shortly after Black emancipation residents rallied to promote racial equality and harmonious living helping to curtail the clout of the Ku Klux Klan Van Camp Company once the largest local employer provided pork and beans for thousands of troops entrenched in World War I and the community's strong agricultural tradition sustained the town through the Great Depression author and historian Tom Rumer chronicles the challenges of growth and change in this history of Westfield and Washington Township

Hearings Before the Committee on Agriculture, House of Representatives, Eighty-fifth Congress 1957 the extraordinary life and crimes of heiress turned revolutionary Rose Dugdale who in 1974 became the only woman to pull off a major art heist in the world of crime there exists an unusual commonality between those who steal art and those who repeatedly kill they are almost exclusively male but as with all things there is always an outlier someone who bucks the trend defying the reliable profiles and leaving investigators and researchers scratching their heads in the history of major art heists that outlier is Rose Dugdale Dugdale's life is singularly notorious born into extreme wealth she abandoned her life as an Oxford-trained PhD and heiress to join the cause of Irish Republicanism while on the surface she appears to be the British version of Patricia Hearst she is anything but Dugdale ran head first towards the action spearheading the first aerial terrorist attack in British history and pulling off the biggest art theft of her time in 1974 she led a gang into the opulent Russborough House in Ireland and made off with millions in prized paintings including works by Goya Gainsborough and Rubens as well as Lady writing a letter with her maid by the mysterious Master Johannes Vermeer Dugdale thus became to this day the only woman to pull off a major art heist and as Anthony Amore explores in *The Woman Who Stole Vermeer* it's likely that this was not her only such heist the woman who stole Vermeer is Rose Dugdale's story from her idyllic upbringing in Devonshire and her presentation to Elizabeth II as a debutante to her university years and her eventual radical lifestyle her life of crime and activism is at turns unbelievable and awe-inspiring and sure to engross readers

Price Support on Certain Varieties of Flue-cured Tobacco 1957 franz jèagerstèatter an austrian farmer devoted husband and father and devout catholic was executed in 1943 for refusing to serve in the nazi army before taking this stand jèagerstèatter had consulted both his pastor and his local bishop who instructed him to do his duty and to obey the law an instruction that violated his conscience for many years jèagerstèatter s solitary witness was honored by the catholic peace movement while viewed with discomfort by many of his fellow austrians now with his beatification in 2007 his example has been embraced by the universal church
