the man behind the mythology set against the vibrant backdrop of the century that shaped him balanchine's radical approach to choreography reinvented the art of dance and his richly evocative ballets made him a lasting legend today nearly thirty years after his death the man is still so revered that the mysteries of his biography are often overlooked who was george balanchine born in russia under the last czar balanchine experienced the upheavals of world war one the russian revolution exile world war two and the cultural cold war he was part of the russian modernist moment a key player in paris in the 1920s and in new york he revolutionized ballet pressing it to the forefront of modernism and making it serious and popular art his influences were myriad he considered himself georgian yet he did not step foot in his ancestral homeland until he was in his fifties he was deeply influenced by the cold grandeur and sensuous beauty of the orthodox church but equally absorbed by the new rhythms and dance steps coming out of harlem in the 1930s he collaborated broadly with figures like diaghilev and stravinsky a man of muses balanchine was married five times always to young dancers and consumed by many other loves in between the difficulties of his life personal losses bouts of ill health debilitating loneliness and dark moods of despair resonate in his dances which speak so poignantly of love and loss and yet the full implications for his art remain unexplored now for the first time we look beyond the myth of mr b the mask which balanchine himself helped to create to see mr b the man

how can an ethics of listening guide the media to contribute to the deepening of democracy in africa in africa the media plays a significant role in conflict management and resolution which conflicts the media report which are ignored and how conflicts are represented can have a profound impact on the outcomes while the media can in some cases ensure the stability of african democracy critics have pointed out that in other cases the media actually increases tensions in areas of conflict the media tends to privilege only elite voices offering superficial coverage of marginalized groups in a way that increases polarization in the ethics of engagement herman wasserman explores the ethics of the media in conflicts that arise during transitions to democracy in africa he examines the roles responsibilities and obligations of media in contexts of high socioeconomic inequality in doing so he looks at ethnic and racial polarization in the histories of colonialism post colonial authoritarianism and hybrid regimes taking a critical view of the normative guidelines and professional identities of journalism inherited from contexts outside of africa he argues that a more reciprocal and collaborative approach is needed he develops a new ethics of engagement that would require the

emotion management is an important source of social capital and synergy for organizations managers have a great role in the creation of this synergy a manager who can cope with their emotions indirectly contributes to organizational effectiveness this situation is especially important in human oriented organizations providing services rather than goods such as educational institutions leadership is a process of social influence which maximizes the efforts of others towards the achievement of a goal leadership stems from social influence rather than authority or power in terms of system approach the input output process and feedback of educational organizations are always related to human behaviors therefore organizations must address the nature of human beings in all of their managerial processes although organizations in which people are at the foreground try to continue their functioning on a rational and formal basis throughout the managerial process they sometimes have to manage emotional and informal phenomena in this case there is a need for managers and school leaders who can shape the rationale in line with the requirements of human nature what is expected from this administrator is that they do not ignore human needs and emotions while providing the management of educational institutions for this reason these managers should be leaders rather than executives who only work in a formal framework of organization management moreover principals and teachers should also be leaders in all educational processes emotions are the main catalyst of positive organizational culture leaders can create an effective organizational culture with the main source of positive emotions between employers positive emotions also motivate employees for organizational purposes if a leader wishes to create and maintain an effective organizational culture it is essential to support positive behavior and emotional climate in their institutes and schools leaders school managers and teachers therefore need to develop emotion management abilities educational organizations need to shape their organizational culture climate and psychology to support their leaders in efficiently managing their employees emotions up to now this topic has been usually addressed as the main catalyst and a sub dimension of emotional intelligence moreover current evidence classifies social and empathy skills as other sub dimensions of emotional intelligence for this reason this collection of peer reviewed articles will draw attention to the contemporary term emotional management and contribute to educational fields by means of exploring the relationship between emotions and leadership
