LED TO A RADICAL REORGANISATION OF ITS DETACHMENTS AND THE DEFINITIVE REALIGNMENT OF ITS POLITICS THUS TRANSFORMED THE OLDER NEW FOURTH ARMY ENGAGES LESS FOR ITS OWN INTRINSIC AND DISTINCTIVE NATURE THAN AS A DIVISION SUBJECT ONLY TO CIRCUMSTANTIAL VARIATION OF THE GENERAL MOVEMENT OF CHINESE COMMUNISM AT WAR THE WANNAN INCIDENT REPRESENTED A TURNING POINT AND IN SOME RESPECTS A DECISIVE BREAK IN THE ARMY S DEVELOPMENT AND THEREFORE FORMS A NATURAL CLIMAX AND FINALE TO THIS STUDY THE BOOK IS THE VOLUME OF MILITARY HISTORY OF THE QING DYNASTY AMONG A SERIES OF BOOKS OF DEEP INTO CHINA HISTORIES CALLIGRAPHY HISTORY LITERATURE AND PHILOSOPHY WERE CAREFULLY SELECTED THROUGH DIFFICULT GOVERNMENT EXAMINATIONS CHINA S LAST DYNASTY WAS THE QING 1644 1912 WHICH WAS REPLACED BY THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA IN 1912 AND IN THE MAINLAND BY THE PEOPLE S REPUBLIC OF CHINA IN 1949 CHINESE HISTORY HAS ALTERNATED BETWEEN PERIODS OF POLITICAL UNITY AND PEACE AND PERIODS OF WAR AND FAILED STATEHOOD THE MOST
