politician as a typical strongman the boss of a semiviolent patronage network that squeezes votes out of the people that standard analysis would utterly fail to recognize and understand the grassroots realities of suphanburi that nishizaki has captured in his study this compassionate well grounded analysis challenges simplistic perceptions of rural thai voters and raises vital questions about contemporary democracy in thailand
