A Mongol Rally Team Experience 2011-07-17 softcover edition this book is about the 9 1 2 weeks i spent traveling through mongolia by horse and by hitchhiking in the summer of 1993 this was a few months after the withdrawal of communist control from the former soviet union i was eighteen years old there was no email and no internet we now know it i could not contact my parents or my family for two months and they had no way to know whether i was alive or dead i was alone but never alone as i was accompanied by mongolian friends and voluntary caretakers almost anywhere i went and whether i liked it or not the book is comprised of slightly edited versions of the journal i kept and the letters i wrote at that time it is meant to communicate what everyday life in mongolia was like through the eyes of a lone american teenager
