medication errors are the most common and preventable cause of patient injury these errors typically involve administering the wrong drug or dose using the wrong route administering it incorrectly or giving medication to the wrong patient this article provides an overview of medication errors for practicing physicians and focuses on medication error 1 terminology and definitions 2 incidence 3 risk factors 4 avoidance strategies and 5 disclosure and legal consequences medication errors occur when weak medication systems and or human factors such as fatigue poor environmental conditions or staff shortages affect prescribing transcribing dispensing administration and monitoring practices which can then result in severe harm disability and even death a medication error is a failure in the treatment process that leads to or has the potential to lead to harm to the patient this article provides an overview of medica tion errors for practicing physicians and fo cuses on medication error 1 terminology and de finitions 2 incidence 3 risk factors 4 avoidance strategies and 5 disclosure and legal consequences a medication error is defined as any preventable event that may cause or lead to inappropriate medication use or patient harm while the medication is in the control of the healthcare medication errors occur at any point of the medication management process and are a major cause of death and harm globally the objective of this review was to compare the effectiveness of different interventions in reducing prescribing dispensing and administration medication errors in acute medical and surgical settings methods technical series on safer primary care medication errors 13 december 2016 technical document download 525 9 kb overview medications are offered by health services throughout the world however with substantial and increasing medication use comes a growing risk of harm as wittich et al note medication errors are common and their type and frequency vary substantially by setting they are much more frequent in intensive care units for example where patients receive an average of 25 medications per day and much less of a problem in areas such as obstetrics where medications are generally avoided medication errors are common events that compromise patient safety and are prevalent in all health care settings a medication error is an error of commission or omission at any step along the pathway that begins when a clinician prescribes a medication and ends when the patient actually receives the medication an adverse drug event ade is defined as harm experienced by a patient as a result of exposure to a medication medications errors mes one of the most types of medical errors could be venomous in clinical settings patients will be harmed physically and psychologically in addition to adverse economic consequences reviewing and understanding the topic of medication error especially by nurses can help in advancing the medical services to patients medication error has also been defined as a reduction in the probability of treatment being timely and effective or an increase in the risk of harm relating to medicines and prescribing compared with generally accepted practice 4 medication errors are defined as the preventable inappropriate use of medications these errors can occur at any point in the process ordering transcribing dispensing administering or monitoring medications a medication error is an unintended failure in the drug treatment process that leads to or has the potential to lead to harm to the patient this document ad dresses medication errors defined as any preventable event that may cause or lead to inappropriate medication use or patient harm while the medication is in the control of the healthcare professional patient or consumer medication errors are major causes of patient harm and death medication errors are preventable adverse events resulting from but not limited to wrong medication wrong dose wrong route wrong time wrong patient wrong documentation of medication ensure best patient care

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
